Good Morning,

Effective November 4, 2015, the EPA has officially designated the Town of Mammoth Lakes as an attainment area for the federal air quality standard for particulate matter. EPA found that the Town has continually met the federal standard since 2009. In addition to the re-designation, the EPA also approved the Mammoth Lakes Air Quality Management Plan (AQMP), which demonstrates that compliance with air quality standards can be maintained through 2030. Mammoth Lakes was designated non-attainment for PM10 in 1987 due to air pollution problems in the winter months caused by wood smoke from residential wood burning and road dust from cinders used on roadways after snow storms.
